On a more encouraging note, we have also witnessed in our midst the wonderful work of the Holy Spirit in bringing revelation and salvation to the lost, repentance and a change of heart to the backslidden, strengthening of the faith of the youth and our young soldiers, and ministry to the elderly and the afflicted. We continue to look to The Lord for raising up more workers into the promised Harvest (Luke 10:2) and to multiply leadership with more opportunities for service and growth.

We recognize that we must, as believers, seek God for our protection as a nation. We remember from the books of the Bible how God has used these threats to bring His people closer to Him, and the blessed results.

As we will soon celebrate the feast of Purim (book of Esther), we are reminded how the story of Esther is just as real today as it was 2500 years ago. Persia (today Iran) threatens us daily with her taunts and her support of Hamas and Hezbollah. Israel is under the same threat today, with the same need to seek God as a nation for her protection. Shalom Dear Friends! Greeting from Kfar Saba, Israel.

Last month, for the first time since 2014, two rockets were launched from Gaza into Tel Aviv. Thankfully, no one was hurt. Hamas, the ruling regime in Gaza, claimed it was a "mistake." Israel has a policy of retaliation striking key strategic military sites of Hamas in Gaza. Last week, another claimed "mistake" was launched from Gaza. The rocket directly hit a home very close to Kfar Saba injuring seven people including 2 children. It was truly a miracle in both instances that no one was killed. These 2 events have triggered a potential war between Israel and Gaza.

Could these events be masking something far more important if Hamas trying to divert attention away from the recent United States acknowledging Israel's sovereignty of the Golan Heights? Attention in the news is now on the potential of war. However, we know what has been clearly established by God in the Bible thousands of years ago... that the boundaries of Israel include The Golan Heights (Joshua 17).

While God is now maintaining peace in our land, there is always a hint of war in our midst. Apartments new and old need to have bomb shelters added on to their living spaces. In the south, near Gaza residents hardly go a night without a threat of a red alert.

We at Hamaayan have the same concern. From the north in Lebanon and Syria and the south in Gaza, we know the threat of war. The rocket that landed 5 miles from Kfar Saba went straight over our city. The Bible says war is imminent, and because of our location, we are in the middle of the target zone from these three threats. We are still in process of raising support and purchasing the basement as well as building it into a bomb shelter. What is now a threat can become a reality at any time. Join with us in prayer for God's protection and provision.







Reclaiming Purim as a Biblical Feast

The Book of Esther is the story of Purim. It reminds us of God's protection of His people. Some 2500 years ago, a threat of complete genocide was averted through the prayer and fasting of a Jewish queen and her family. We are commanded to celebrate with great joy God's salvation.



"What are Messianic Jews anyway?"

Just before the Feast of Purim, we invited some Holocaust survivors from our city, for lunch and a concert at our congregation. This was not the first time we had a celebration with these dear people, but it was the first time that one of them, right after the concert stood up and asked, "How is it that all these evangelical missionaries believe in our God? The Jews await the Messiah, and the Gentiles believe he came and will come back again, so is there a difference? And what are Messianic Jews anyway?" What came next was a clear and wonderful explanation of the Gospel. Please pray for these special people to receive God's gift.

War from Gaza

Starting at 10:00 am last Shabbat, Hamas terrorists from Gaza have launched over 650 rockets into Israel in 2 days. As we write now, 150 Israelis are injured, some of them in critical condition, with 4 killed. Numerous buildings damaged include a kindergarden and schools. Countless people are traumatized among the southern population in Israel, including the cities of Sderot, Beer Sheva, Ashdod, Ashkelon, Rehovot etc.

At the same time 10:00 am on Saturday, when the Hamas launched their fire, our intercessor team in Kfar-Saba was praying for our upcoming congregation shabbat meeting. How awesome that we were able to pray through during the rockets for protection for the people down south. The Lord comforted us with the reminder that « The Lord of Israel neither slumber not sleep, the keeper of Israel » Psalm 121.4.

What is Next?

Last night, our air force retaliated by bombing more than 300 tactical Hamas sites including rocket launching sites, terror tunnels and terror offices headquarters. As Hamas has proclaimed earlier: *Terror targets Israel, and now the IDF targets terror back*.

When Will It End?

As we know, there can be no true peace in Israel (or anywhere in the world) without the coming of the Prince of Peace. Peace is not the absence of war, but it is the presence of God. It is *a fruit of the spirit* (Galatians 5.22) growing from the tree of righteousness.

Our Lord is Himself our Peace and our Righteousness. In Israel we all need to return to the Lord with all our hearts. We invite you to pray with us Solomon's prayer from **2 Chroniques 6**.

Last week we remembered the 6 million Jews murdered during WW2, and this week again we are also remembering the cost of thousands of lives, killed for the independence of modern Israel. Amidst the sirens of remembrance of the past, we are now responding to the sirens of today calling us to find shelter in our bomb shelters under the Wings and Shadow of the Almighty. « Lord, in judgement, remember Mercy ».

Join Us in Prayer:

- For our nation to be safe as we gather for national Memorial Day and Independence Day this week.
- For safety for all the cities of the south including Sderot, Ashdod, Ashkelon and Beer Sheva. For healing of shock and trauma, especially for the young children.
- For violence (biblical word: Hamas) to be stopped.
- For our young congregation in Beer Sheva as they minister the message of salvation and hope. They spent all night in bomb shelters. Pray for boldness and fruits during this trying period.
- For our young soldiers to be safe and wise. We have a few members of our congregation serving near Gaza.
- For our government to make wise and courageous decisions.
- For the Body of Messiah to be a light to the whole nation. It is so encouraging to see that northern congregations in Galilee are offering hospitality to brothers & sisters of the Negev (south). What an example of care and love.
- For God to intervene & for the Gospel to be proclaimed in the Gaza strip. Pray for courageous Arab speaking servants of God who are ministering to a lost & hopeless people. Let's all pray for a harvest of souls and that Gaza will come to salvation.

Three More Prayer Items for the Month

- Pray for our upcoming conference « Kingdom First ». We will gather, Arab & Jewish believers for 48 hours of prayer, worship, fellowship & studying God's Word, demonstrating the reality of the « one new man » the root revelation of the Mystery of Messiah (Ephesians 1 & 2). There is not a better time than now to unite as one body seeking His Kingdom First.
- For our next outreach in Tel Aviv next Saturday, as we feed the poor & the needy, ministering to the needs of the body & the soul. Reaching out to both Jewish and Arab population as well as foreign refugees.
- We also remember the terror tragedy and martyrdom in Sri Lanka that happened on Easter Sunday. We were able to minister & encourage some of the Sri Lankan community in Tel Aviv. As we pray for this wounded & traumatized nation, we have been able to identify in some of their suffering, due to our common experiences with terror here in Israel.

Through these challenges, **God has used us to bring healing and reconciliation** in ways we could have never imagined. We have seen Him use us throughout the world to teach about the Mystery of Israel and how it relates to the nations of the world.

We can only imagine what God has in store for us individually and as a congregation. We do know that it is beyond our dreams.

The Feast of Shavuot

Our 30th anniversary was celebrated during the Feast of Shavuot on the rooftop of our building. This is an appointed Feast of the Lord, when the people of Israel were to give their first fruits to God in thanksgiving for what He has done. (Leviticus 23:16-21.)

We enjoyed listening to the testimonies of different members who shared how God has touched their lives through the congregation when they joined it, each one in a different time.

We turned the meeting room into **«Hamaayan Museum»** displaying the historical timeline of our congregation through pictures, videos & many memories.





Kingdom First!

While the world wants to "fix" the Middle East through political means, we know the only way is through the Kingdom of God first. Four years ago, we started to deepen our relationships with our Arab brothers and sisters living under the Palestinian authorities. Last month 80 of us Jews and Arabs met for three days with the goal of gathering to deepen our level of unity, understanding and cooperation. We hope to work together as one team, crossing political borders, in order to become one voice that will bring Glory to God by declaring a clear message of Salvation and Hope to both of our communities.

We want to see Yeshua's Kingdom come and bring forth a great harvest in Israel. We recognize that we need each other and cannot do it on our own.



The March of Life in Israel

The March of Life movement started in Germany in 2007, when **descendants of Nazi perpetrators broke the silence about their terrible family history** and met with Holocaust survivors and their descendants. **The result was healing, friendship and new life.** But it did not just stay in Germany, **about 40,000 people have taken to the streets in 18 nations and 350 cities** with a joint voice for remembrance and reconciliation — against anti-Semitism and for Israel.

This year, one of the cities chosen to host the march was our city Kfar Saba. It was a humbling experience to participate in the March as Jews and Christians walking hand in hand proclaiming: "Israel, you are not alone! We stand together with you in friendship!" Standing on the stage in front of holocaust survivors & the mayor & citizens of Kfar Saba, the young German people asked for forgiveness for the sins that their forefathers committed against the Jewish people. It was a moving moment!

Prayer Requests:

- The upcoming election, that God would raise up Godly leaders who will seek God first and His ways instead of personal gain or agenda.
- God would **forgive** our sins of allowing abortion and "alternative lifestyles" into this land and **heal** our hearts to **return back to Him.**
- For the government and military to make wise decisions in response to the instability of Gaza and Syria/Lebanon. For God to protect the innocent citizens of both the south of Israel and Gaza that are caught in the middle of this conflict.
- **Protection of our soldiers.** Special grace and strength for those who are believers, that they may be a light to those around them.
- The children's summer camps. That our children would receive deeper revelation of God's love and will all be saved.
- God would **provide our final funds** to purchase the basement/bomb shelter, and the final papers needed.
- Wisdom for our leadership team to carry out God's call on our ministry.
- The Harvest in Kfar Saba and surrounding communities, and workers for the harvest.



As we reflect on the past, present and future, we cannot thank God enough for you, our partners who have stood with us all these years. Through your prayers and financial giving, God has allowed us to accomplish what were once dreams and now reality.

Dear Friends and Partners,

For the first time in the modern history of Israel, we are about to have an unprecedented second general election in the same year. On **September 17**, our nation will, once again, try to choose a coalition (majority) to run our government in the Knesset. Dear Friends and Partners.

As we write you this letter, the whole south of Israel and the center of the country including the larger Tel Aviv «Gush Dan» most populated area, are under missile's attacks, up to 80 kilometers radius.
